1. STARTING POINT

 "Regional cooperation" - need to move from "talk show" to "substance"

 Regional generation adequacy assessments (Pentalateral + cosentec/r2b) proved real synergies of regional cooperation

- Germany's intention to consult market design with its "electricity neighbours"
- Stepwise growing discussion on real substance
- Identified common view on several "no-regrets" <u>not</u> only between "like minded"
- Agreed on a concrete declaration
- It is not a closed shop

2. CENTRAL "NO-REGRETS" OF THE DECLARATION

- Maximizing the benefits of the internal market
- Principle of flexibilisation of supply and demand as "no-regret"
- Flexible prices, <u>no</u> legal price caps
- Regional adequacy assessments (common methodology, joint report)
- No restriction of cross-border trade in times of scarcity and following EU regulation on cross-border trade and secure system operation
- Grid reinforcement and further market coupling to increase cross-border trade
 - concrete and substantial



3. WHAT IS THE MAIN ADDED VALUE?


- 12 Member States set clear political priorities
- Declaration on substantial points fosters concrete debate
- Joint learning curve ownership trust building
- Based on very valuable concrete work of the Pentalateral Forum
- Common understanding on high political level
 supports EU-28 regulation
- Commission actively involved to give guidance
- Process as well as the "no-regret approach" could serve as a blueprint



4. Possible "blueprint" elements

- Right mix of "top-down" coordination and "bottom-up" contribution needed
- "Bottom-up" needs
 - substance to be discussed
 - concrete procedure and structure
 - monitoring
- Stronger coordination by COM needed
 - ensure progress and consistency of clusters
 - putting the right questions
- Identifying "no-regrets" allows for deeper integration between different approaches
- Thereby moving forward to better EU-28 regulation





5. NEXT STEPS

- Declaration of "electricity neighbours" to be signed on 8 June "hand in hand" with 10 year Penta-Declaration
- Concrete rules for EU-governance needed
- EU governance need to be "upgraded" in areas of EU targets
- Projects should support substance of regional cooperation ("learning by doing")

Incentives for regional projects needed:

- by the EU governance
- and through an EU-fund providing grants for first "kick-off" regional projects
